## Last Day to Submit Stayover Requests



### Winter Break Housing Closure Reminder

Residential buildings will be closed beginning Sunday, December 17, 2023, at 5 PM and will re-open to residents on Friday, January 19, 2024, at 10 AM. This closure will include all the residential buildings. Housing residents will not have access to the building or suite/room during this time period.

**Please Note:** Residents **DO NOT** have to take belongings home during the Winter Break (except any valuables).

**Package Pick-Up:** The last day to pick up packages for the Fall Semester will be December 15th. Packages that are not picked up will be sent back to the sender. Residents are encouraged to plan ahead.

### Stayover Request

Residents who need housing during the Winter Break must request a Winter Break Stayover Request through the Housing Portal between **November 15th, 2023 to December 1st, 2023**.

#### Important Information:

- Based on operational needs, students who remain on campus may be required to stay in a temporary location for the full duration of the break.
  - Meal plans **are not** active during this time, and on-campus dining options will be limited.
    - Fall meal plans will end with dinner on **December 15, 2023**
    - Spring meal plans will begin with dinner on **January 19, 2024**
  - Approved stayovers will be charged \$40/day, with a max charge of \$560.00

### Spring Meal Plan Change Tool

The Meal Plan Change tool for Spring Semester is available on the [CPP Housing Portal](#) and will close **December 6, 2023**. Your new meal plan for Spring Semester will be effective beginning with dinner on Friday, January 19, 2024.

#### Please Note:

- This is a great time to decrease your meal plan because meal plan decreases will not be allowed during the Spring term.
  - You can increase your meal plan at any time during the semester.

### Not Returning for Spring Semester?

If you are graduating early or withdrawing from the university, please remember that you must **submit a Petition to Cancel** and supplemental documentation to the University Housing Office as soon as possible. Please understand that all requests to cancel your housing contract must meet the criteria listed in the Housing License Agreement and must be approved by University Housing Services. Please email our office to request a Petition to Cancel form at [housing@cpp.edu](mailto:housing@cpp.edu).

Please Note: Per the 2023-2024 Housing License Terms and Agreement, residents terminating their Housing License Agreement early will be responsible for fees up to 30 days into Spring Semester if the Petition to Cancel is submitted after the deadline (November 13, 2023).
